- 3. Am I guarding my heart?** (Pr 4:23; 1 Sam. 16:7; Col. 3:1-2; Mt. 5:6, 8; 15:18-20; Phil. 4:6-7)
- 4. Is my humility genuine?** (Mt. 5:3; 1 Pet. 5:5-6; Phil. 2:3-4; Ps. 51:17)
- 5. Is transformation taking place in my heart?** (2 Co. 3:18; Ro. 12:2; Ga. 4:19; 1 Pet. 1:15-16; 2 Pet. 1:4-9)
- 6. What does my heart say is my true identity?** (Eph. 1:3-14; Ro. 8:28; Heb. 4:16; 10:19-22)
- 7. Do I sincerely love my neighbor?** (Mk. 12:31; 1 Pet. 3:8-12; 5:3-6; Col. 3:12-16)
- 8. How is the contentment factor?** (Phil. 4:11-13; 1 Pet. 1:6-8; 2:28-24; 1 Thess. 5:16-18)
- 9. What is the measure of my integrity?** (Eph. 4:22-30; Gal. 5:19-23; 2 Pet. 1:8-11)
- 10. Do I believe God and live in radical dependence on Him?** (Jn. 15:5; Mt. 26:41; 1 Cor. 3:5; 12:9-10; Col. 1:26-29)
